Carrying out work on your own boats

Definitions

We, us: Will Squibb Ltd, and its Directors.

Who does this document apply to?


This document applies to non-tradespersons who are undertaking work privately on their own vessel.

Owners of boats stored externally on our premises are welcome to carry out work on their own boats. Many of the rules that apply to our contractors apply however, which you should read and familiarise before starting work.

Please remember that you are within a working environment, and as such the same rules that would apply in your workplace would apply here. Please also remember that any tools or equipment (such as ladders, power tools, etc) belong to the yard and may be required for someone to undertake work elsewhere on another boat.

- Please discuss the work you are intending to carry out with one of our staff before starting any work. Whilst this might also be a chance to get the odd hint and tip as to the best way to do it, we want to ensure you know what you are doing and have the skills and equipment to undertake the work safely. We have a responsibility to protect our staff, contractors, visitors to the site and the general public, so we need to know what you're planning to do.
- Be aware that you may be charged for any equipment 'borrowed' without prior agreement, and that if a task excessively involves our staff to assist or guide you this time may be chargeable.
- Familiarise yourself with the evacuation procedures and emergency assembly points.
- For specific tasks we may require a full risk assessment
- Work may only be carried out within standard business hours (Mon-Fri, 0800-1730) except by prior arrangement.
- Be aware of other boats **before** starting work. Please do not use welding, cutting or grinding equipment where there is a likelihood of damage to other boats nearby (eg. From sparks, hot filings). You should check for any flammable substances nearby (eg. boat fuel tanks).
- Please consider other boats, equipment or people nearby when undertaking tasks that create dust or excessive noise.
- If you are intending to carry out any hot work you are responsible for ensuring adequate fire fighting equipment is nearby. When leaving an area in which hot work has been carried out within the previous 60 minutes then please ensure that a member of our staff is made aware of where and what work has been carried out.
- If you are asked to stop work by any member of our staff, please do so immediately.
- Smoking is only permitted outside. Please ensure any cigarette ends are disposed of safely and appropriately. Beware of any flammable substances nearby when smoking (eg. fuel tanks on ribs).
- Please dispose of any refuse yourself (except by prior agreement). Disposal for any waste left otherwise may be chargeable.

Contractors who are in breach of the above may be asked to leave the site.
